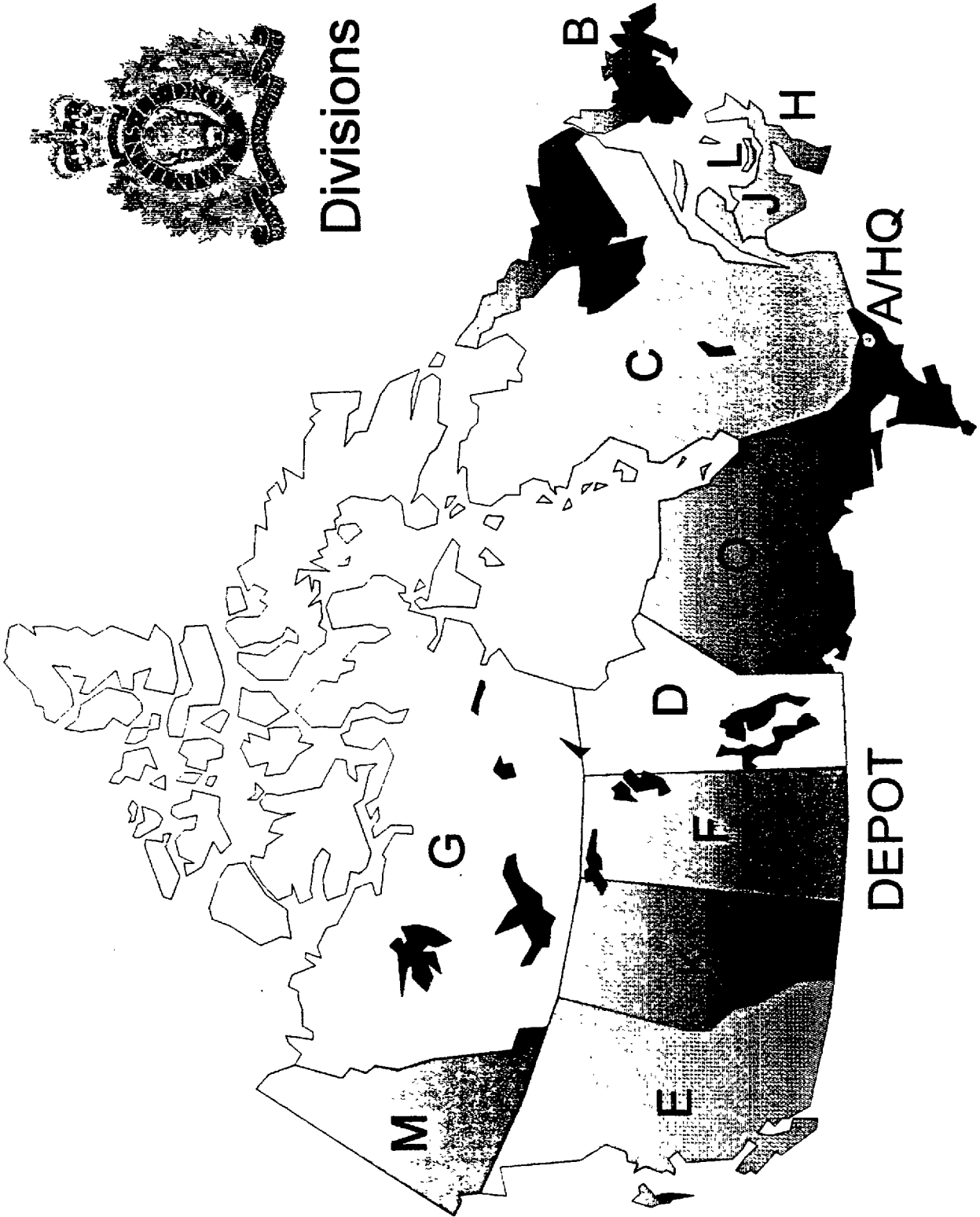

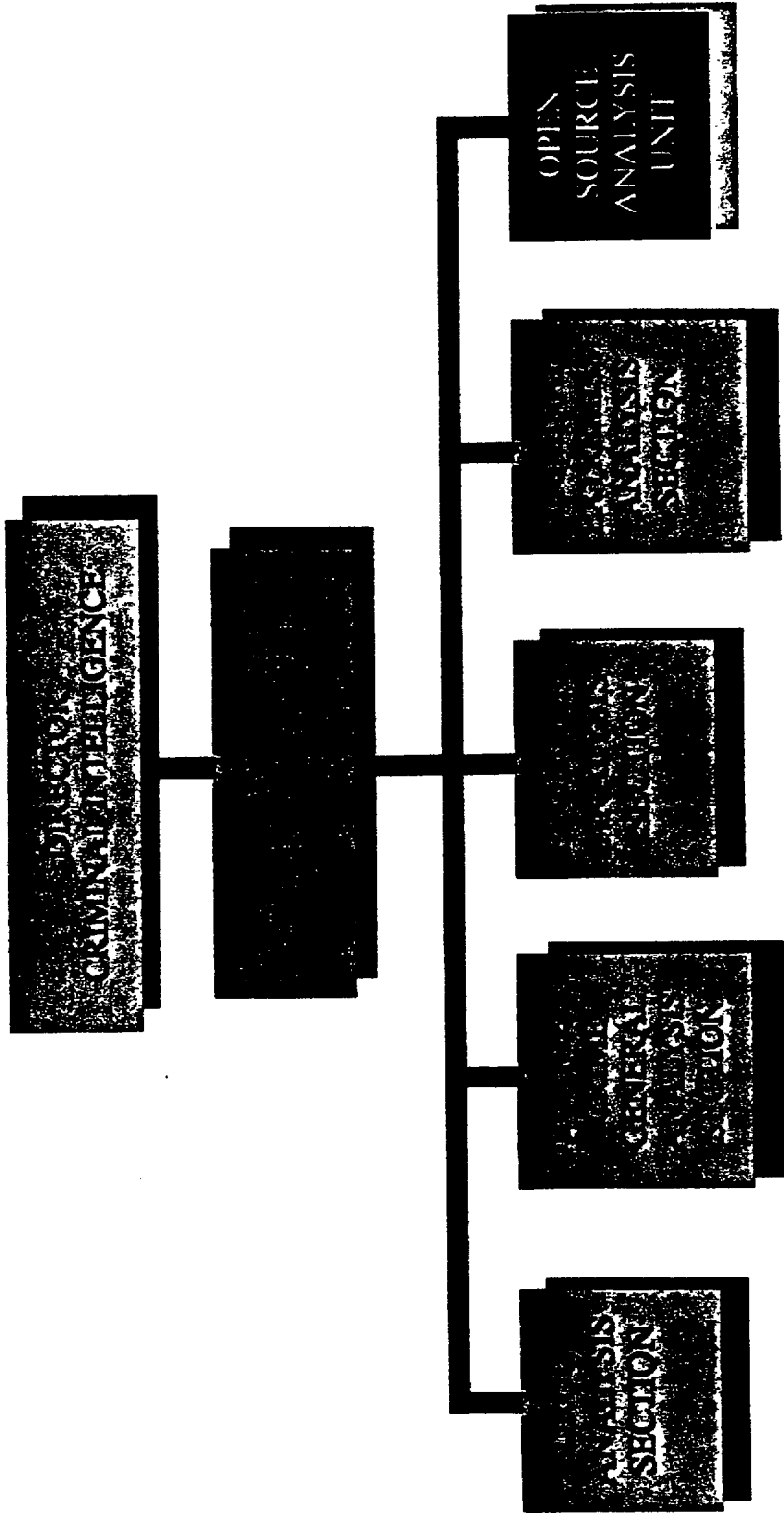

- Indicates the need to change operational focus and tactical priorities

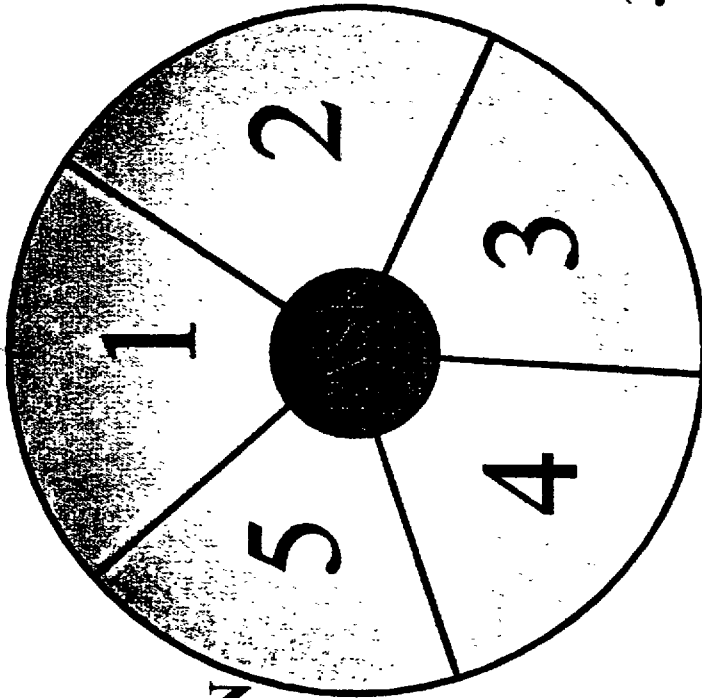
TACTICAL ANALYSIS

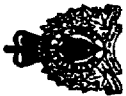
